## Tension

15sts and 22 rows to $4^{\prime \prime}$ ( 10 cms ) on 5.50 mm needles over reversed stocking stitch.

Abbreviations
K - knit
P - purl
St(s) - stitch(es)
Beg - beginning
RS - right side
WS - wrong side
Tog - together
SI - slip

Psso - pass slip st over
M1 - make 1 st by picking up horizontal loop from row below and knitting into back.
CB4 - place first 2sts onto cable needle at back, then k2, then k2 from cable needle.

## Back

Using 4.50 mm needles, cast on 94(101, 108)sts
1st row: ( $\mathrm{p} 3, \mathrm{k} 4$ ) to last 3sts, p3.
2nd row: (k3, p4) to last 3sts, k3.
3rd row: (p3, CB4) to last 3sts, p3.
4th row: as 2nd row.
Repeat last 4 rows of pattern until work measures $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
( 6 cms )ending on 3rd row of pattern.
Dec row: (k3, p1, p2tog,
p1) to last 3sts, k3.
81(87, 93)sts.
Change to 5.50 mm
needles and reversed st st as follows:
1st row: pur|
2nd row: knit Repeat last 2 rows until work measures 15(15 $1 / 2$, 16)" 38(40, 42)cms.

Shape Raglan armholes
Cast off 3sts at beg of next 2 rows. 75(81,
87)sts.

1st row: k2, sl1, k1, psso, purl to last 4sts, k2tog, k2.
2nd row: p3, k to last
3sts, p3.
3rd row: k3, $p$ to last 3sts, k3.
4th row: as 2nd row. Repeat last 4 rows 1(1, 2)times 71(77, 81)sts. Repeat rows 1 and 2 to 53(55, 57)sts ending on WS row.
Next row: as 1st row Next row: p2, p2togtbl, k to last 4sts, p2tog, p2. Repeat last 2 rows until $21(23,25)$ sts remain. Leave sts on st holder.

## Front

Work as for Back unti 55(57, 59)sts remain after armhole shaping, ending on WS row.

## Shape neck

Next row: k2, sl1k1, psso, p19(20, 21)sts, turn, leaving remaining sts on st holder. Work 1 row. 1st row: k2, sl1, k1, psso, p to last 2sts, k2tog. 2nd row: k to last 4sts, p2togtbl, p2.
Repeat last 2 rows 5(5, 6) more times. 4(5, 3)sts. Next row: (p2tog)
twice(twice, once), p0(1, 1).

Next row: k2tog(k3tog,
k2tog). Fasten off.
Returning to sts on st holder, place centre 7(9, 9)sts on st holder, purl to last 4sts, k2tog, k2.
Work 1 row.
1st row: k2tog, p to last 4sts, k2tog, k2.
2nd row: $\mathrm{p} 2, \mathrm{p} 2$ tog, k to end of row.
Repeat last 2 rows $5(5,6)$ more times. 4(5, 3)sts
Next row: $p 0(1,1)$ st,
p2tog twice(twice, once).
Next row: k2tog(k3tog, k2tog). Fasten off.

Sleeves (work 2)
Using 4.50mm needles,
cast on $50(57,64)$ sts
1st row:p2(k4, p3) to
last 6sts, k4, p2.
2nd row: k2(p4, k3) to
last 6sts, p4, k2.
3rd row: p2 (CB4, p3) to last 6sts, CB4, p2.
4th row: as 2nd row.
Repeat last 4 rows, twice more.
Change to 5.50 mm needles and reversed st s . Inc 1 st at each end of every 3rd row
To 64(71, 78)sts. Cont straight until sleeve measures 7" (18cms) from beg ending on WS row.

## Shape raglan

Cast off 3sts at beg of next 2 rows.58(65, 72)sts
1st row: k2, sl1,k1,psso, purl to last 4sts, k2tog, k2
2nd row: p3, $k$ to last 3sts, p3.
3rd row: k3, p to last 3sts, k3.
4th row: as 2nd row.
Repeat last 4 rows $3(2,2)$
times more. 50(59, 66)sts.
Repeat rows 1 and 2, 5(8,
$11)$ times. $40(43,44)$ sts
Next row: as 1st row.
Next row: p2, p2tog, $k$ to last 4sts, p2togtbl, p2. Repeat last 2 rows to 6(7, 8)sts finighing on WS row. Place sts on st holder.

## Finishing

Join raglan seams.

## Neckband

Using 4.50 mm circular needle, and starting with sts on st holder for left sleeve, work as follows 1st size: (k3, m1, k3), pick up 12 sts from left front, (p3, m1, p4) across sts on holder for front
Pick up 12 sts from right front, (k3, m1, k3) across sts on holder for right sleeve, (k3, m1, p7, m1, $\mathrm{p} 8, \mathrm{~m} 1, \mathrm{k} 3$ ) across sts on holder for Back (70sts). Place marker.
2nd size: (k3, m1, p1, k3), pick up 12sts from left front, (p3, m1, p3, m1,
p3) across sts on holder For front, pick up 12sts from right front, k3(p1, $\mathrm{m} 1, \mathrm{k} 3$ ) across sts for right sleeve, (k3, m1, p8 m1, p9, m1, k3)across sts on holder for Back. (77sts) Place marker
3rd size: (k3, m1, p2, k3), pick up 13sts from left front, ( $\mathrm{p} 3, \mathrm{~m} 1, \mathrm{p} 1$, m1, p2, m1, k3) across sts on holder for front, pick up 13sts from right front, (k3, p2, m1, k3) across sts on holder for right sleeve, (k3, m1, p9, m1, p10, m1, k3) across sts on holder for back (84)sts. Place marker.

## Working in rounds,

 continue as follows:1st round: $(p 3, k 4)$ to marker
2nd round: as 1st row.
3rd round: (p3, CB4) to marker.
4th round: as 2nd round.
Repeat last 4 rounds
twice. Cast off loosely in pattern.
Join side and sleeve seams. Press lightly.
